



Research Report

Paper Due: Wednesday, March 10

Instead of writing a book report, this quarter you will be researching and writing a paper about your job for the Colonial Village. It will include submission of the following parts of the research process:

- Resources Sheet (using at least 4 resources, two books and two online articles)
- Note cards (at least 4 per each of the required resources)
- Outline
- Research paper
- In-class oral presentation (using the PowerPoint slideshow that is created for computer class)
- Display for Colonial Village

To help each student stay on target, there will be due dates assigned for each step in the research process. While there will be some time dedicated to this in school, a majority of the work will need to be done at home. You will be using what you learn from your research to create a table display of your job for our Colonial Village, to be presented at the Learning Celebration on March 14. I will give a grade for completing each part of the research process on time, handing in all parts of the completed research report, the oral presentation, and the Colonial Village display.

The research paper needs to be typed, using 12-point Times New Roman or Arial font, and double spaced. You will need to have a cover page, 3-4 pages of your research report, and a bibliography of your resources. Your cover page needs to have a title, your name, your grade, and the due date. For your bibliography, you will use the information you recorded on your resource sheet and type it into the bibliography format (see sheet with examples), adding the page to the back of your research paper. Please proof-read your paper as points will be taken off for excessive spelling and grammar errors.
