

Since this is re-registration time, I want to highlight the forms I will need for the 2010-2011 school year. These forms are located on the school website: www.oursaviorsschool.com under Enrollment, then Forms, in the left column. Print out the form(s) that apply to your child(ren), take the appropriate steps for completion, (some notes require doctor's signature or approval) and return to the school, to the attention of the school nurse.

Once your plans for 2010-2011 are firm, please start sending the forms to me. I am accepting medical forms for the 2010-2011 year now.

All students:

Please read the Introductory Nurse Letter to Parents.

Print and fill out the Emergency Health Contact Form. This form gives consent for emergency treatment if necessary, and your preferred treatment location. This form will be kept confidential.

Print and fill out the Health History Form. This form gives me a better understanding of any health challenges your child has or is facing. It is kept confidential.

All new students and students entering grades K, 2, 4, and 7:

Print and take the Physical Form to be filled out by your healthcare provider. A physical dated on or after September 8, 2009 will be acceptable for the 2010-2011 school year. This physical is **required**. Also include a copy of your student(s) immunizations.

Print out and sign the Body Mass Index form if you do not want your student's BMI data included in the 2010-2011 BMI survey.

The Dental Certification form is requested, but not required of all new students and those entering Grades K, 2, 4, and 7.

All students who need to take medicine during the school day (including acetaminophen and ibuprofen and Benadryl):

Print and take the Authorization for Administration of Medicine to your healthcare provider.

This form authorizes me to administer prescription and over-the-counter medicine to your child. This form needs to be redone **each** school year. Parents **need to provide all prescription medication** in pharmacy-labeled containers with the child name, medicine, dosage, and strength.

Over-the-counter medications also need to be provided by the parent. These may be submitted in the original packaging, labeled with the student's name.

All students who have a chronic health condition (ex. Asthma, allergies, diabetes, etc.):

Print out the action care plan form appropriate for your child's condition and take it to your healthcare provider's office for completion. If your child's condition is not listed on the school website, please call me at 459-2273 and I will provide you with the form appropriate for your child's condition.
